Coaching Code

- Enthusiastically support and practice the “Everyone Plays”, “Good Sportsmanship”, and “Positive Coaching” philosophies.
- Be reasonable in your demands on a young player’s time, energy, enthusiasm, and performance on the football field.
- Impress on your players that they must abide by all the Laws of the Games at all times.
- Develop team respect for the ability of opponents, and for the judgment of referees and opposing coaches.
- Ensure that your players’ football/cheerleading experience is one of fun and enjoyment (winning is only part of it). Players should never be yelled at or ridiculed for making mistakes or losing a game.
- Set a good example and be generous with your praise when it is deserved. Children need a coach they can respect.
- Keep informed of sound principles of coaching, growth and child development.
- Check your equipment and playing facilities. They should meet safety standards and be appropriate for the age and ability of your players.
- Follow the advice of a physician when determining when an injured child is ready to play again.

Specific Coaches Rules:

1. No Tobacco Products, E Cigs, Drugs, or Alcohol are to be used during practices, games or any other NOFA Event when children are present.
2. Coaches must be committed to the Program from time of application till the end of November.
3. Coaches are responsible for their Team/Squad throughout the entire season.
4. Coaches are responsible for making sure your Team/Squad are properly outfitted with all the necessary equipment/uniforms.
5. No Verbal or Physical Abuse will be tolerated by any Coach to his/her Player/Cheerleader. Any Verbal or Physical Abuse will result in immediate dismissal or any and all parties involved.
6. No Coach, at any time, will engage in any Verbal or Physical confrontation with any Parent, Coach, Referee or Participant. If any confrontation should take place it will result in immediate suspension and possible dismissal of all Coaches involved.

If accepted for a coaching position, I hereby agree to abide by the philosophies, the coach’s code, the rules and regulations set forth and the decisions of the NOFA Board.

I understand that the information which I have furnished herein is subject to verification, which will include a criminal background check. I also understand I cannot register for any training until my National Background Check is Complete.
